CHHS SPANISH BILINGUAL INFORMATION

When students come to Crescent Heights in Grade 10, they will belong to two communities - the Spanish Bilingual Program and the Regular Program. Each student will have a learning team that consists of their Spanish bilingual teachers, an assistant principal and a guidance counselor. Students are supported by this team throughout their high school experience to ensure academic success and social wellbeing.

Spanish Bilingual students take two Spanish courses per year. We are a semestered school so this offers flexibility for when students can take their Spanish courses since they are offered in both semesters/multiple times a year.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why will Social Studies be taught in Spanish instead of Math at the Grade 10 level? The outcomes for Social Studies 10 are focused on globalization, citizenship, and the exploration of current events from a variety of perspectives. These outcomes allow students to make authentic, real-world connections and explore culturally and socially relevant topics in a class that has a high level of oral language production. For a few specific outcomes, students will have the option to demonstrate curricular knowledge, skills and attitudes in English to prep them for SS 20 in Grade 11.

What supports exist to support students with math if they are struggling with this course as they transition to CHHS?

- Math 15 with CBe-learn in summer school after Grade 9
- Math 10-3 plus CHHS skill building course where students move through Math 10-3 at a quicker pace and then prep to take Math 10C
- CHHS Tutorials offered Monday to Thursday from 8:15 to 8:45
