What do I do if ...

What do I do if I have concerns, questions or issues about my child's marks, assessment, assignments or course work?

Speaking directly with your child's teacher is always the best first approach. The teacher works directly with students and is best able to discuss the details of class learning activities, forms of assessment, practices and policies.

Contact can be made via email (available on course outline or school website), voice mail or a telephone call to the school. Drop-in visits and unscheduled appointments are not possible due to the nature of teacher work, school safety and security, as well as administration's practices regarding the importance of structured meeting times.

What do I do if I have a question about my child's lates or absences?

MyCBE is an environment that all parents can register for and use to track their child's attendance and marks. The environment is live and parents can register using the link found on the Calgary Board of Education webpage. If you have trouble, please contact the main office. https://www.cbe.ab.ca/mycbe

What do I do if I have concerns, questions or issues about my child's school team/extra-curricular, decisions, actions, playing time?

Speaking directly first with your child's coach/teacher is the best course of action. The coach works directly with students and is best able to discuss the details of any concerns, questions or issues you may have. If concerns remain after speaking with the coach, then contact with the athletic directors/learning leader is your next step.

Drop-in visits and unscheduled appointments are not possible due to the nature of teacher work, school safety and security, as well as administration's practices regarding the importance of structured meeting times.

What types of concerns/questions and issues should I contact the principal about? Why should I contact others instead of the principal?

If discussions have occurred with those most closely involved (teachers, learning leaders, counsellors, assistant principals), and concerns still remain, then contacting the principal is appropriate. The idea of "starting at the top" may work well in companies, groups or organizations with a different, smaller, or more compacted structure. The daily work of a high school principal involves both instructional leadership and managerial tasks. While interactions with students are ongoing, they may lack the consistency and proximity of teachers, learning leaders, counsellors and even assistant principals.
